COVID-19

Symptoms: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of or change to sense of smell or taste. A symptomatic person must stay home and be tested. Please let us know if someone in your household has any of the symptoms, and if they test positive for the virus. It is important everyone follows the guidelines such as social distancing, wearing face coverings when appropriate, and frequent hand washing. Most of our staff team members are participating in symptom-free COVID testing. There are also asymptomatic tests available for all Kent residents. Our risk assessment is available on our nursery website.

Clothes and shoes

Please make sure your child has at least two sets of spare clothes in their nursery bag each day and that they have waterproof clothes to wear outside in the rain. Please also provide separate indoor and outdoor footwear for your child.

Cancelled staff development day / Extra day open

As we have had plenty of time for staff to complete training when they were working from home, we have decided to open the nursery on Thursday 8th April 2021. Funded hours will **not** apply to this date and so we are happy to take bookings for children in Farm, Sea, or Garden rooms to attend Thursday 8th April regardless of whether they normally attend on a Thursday or not (subject to availability).
