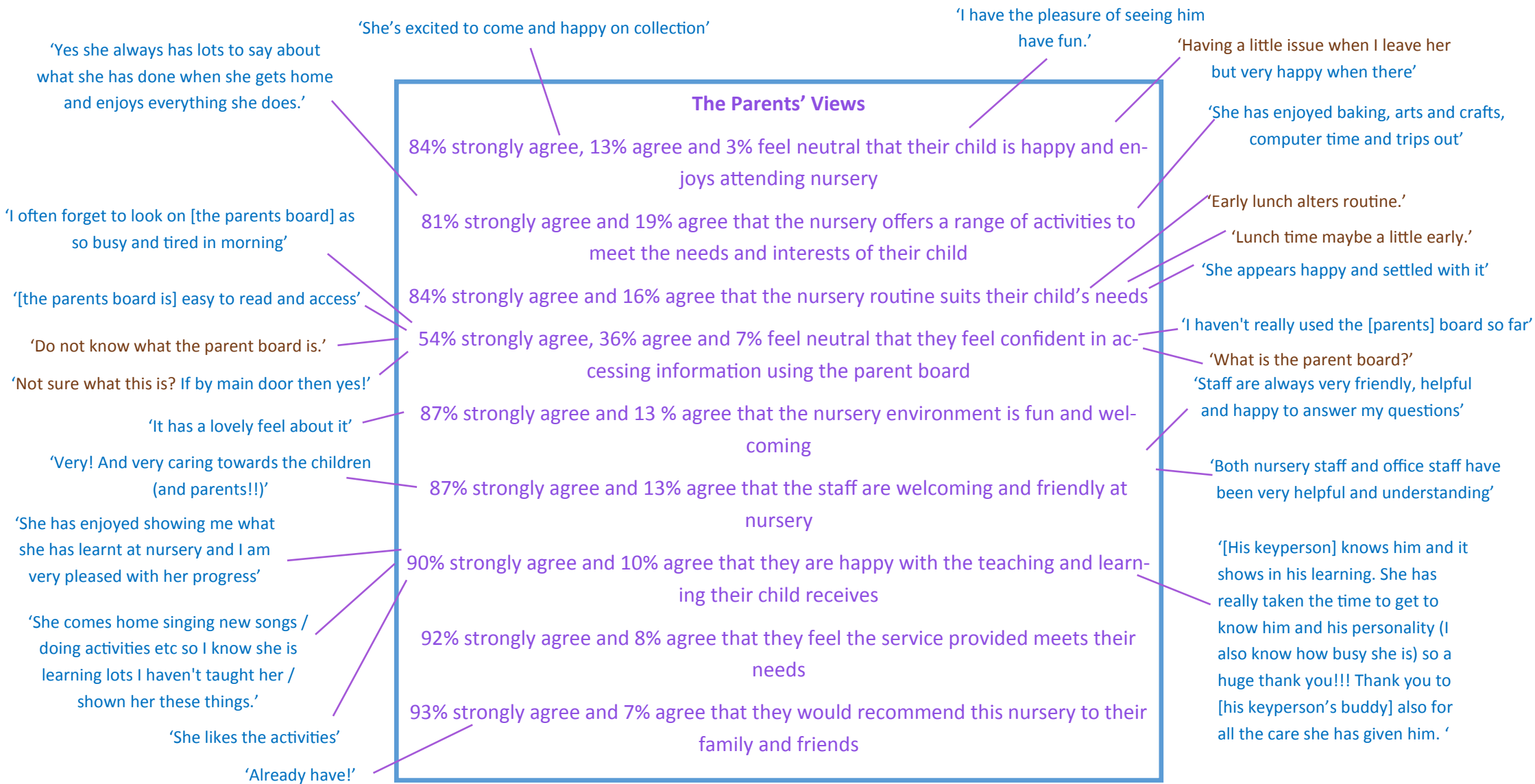

The Negative Comments and our responses

'The staff I feel need to be a bit more welcoming in the mornings to all children not just your key children.'

We try our best to ensure children feel welcomed at nursery, and have had a lot of feedback to say we achieve this. We have fed this comment back in a staff meeting to ensure all staff are welcoming all children in future.

'Encouraging children to drink their water from their bottles more and get the children to clean their faces after lunch'

Staff frequently ask children to drink water from their bottles, as well as water or milk at snack and mealtimes. Part of our daily routine is to have children wash their faces after mealtimes. These comments will be passed on to staff to ensure this is happening consistently.

'I'm a bit confused about the gates being opened and closed... the side gate especially...'

Our last newsletter explains the times and reasoning for this. The school gates have been opened and closed by school staff to ensure safety for the children. This comment will be passed on to school staff.

A comment regarding negative feedback regarding a child's behaviour. Staff try to tailor the feedback they give to parents by what the parent specifically would like to know. We have discussed this comment with your key person.

'Have given email address to enable access to online system but still not received information'
